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Surgery Follow-Up Care Instructions

- 1. Apply a warm compress (soaked in a clean wash cloth in warm tap water) for 10 minutes followed by an ice compress for 5 minutes. Repeat this 4 times a day for approximately one week or until swelling resolves.
- 2. Continue to apply Vaseline for two (2) days after stitches are removed, or for one (1) week if you have dissolvable sutures.
- 3. You may resume wearing contact lenses when your eyelids feel comfortable enough to insert your lenses, usually after the first postoperative visit.
- 4. Sunlight and artificial sunlamp to exposed suture line(s) may cause permanent redness. Sun block of SPF 50 is recommended.
- 5. Tightness and redness along your incision line, often associated with small lumps for 6-8 weeks following surgery, can be expected, resolving in about 6-12 months.
